"Life of a Tree" Story Tree Specie:

By looking at a tree cookie (a cross-section of a tree), you can read the story of that tree's life. You can see the different events that happened to it and the environment it lived in. You can tell where it lived, if it went through a drought, or was affected by disease, competition, or even fire. You can also see when it experienced excellent growing conditions with lots of sunshine, water, and nutrients to feed on.

Assignment

Your job is to choose a tree that is commonly found in Alberta or BC and tell its life. The **five** events/conditions must be realistic and believable for a tree.

In your final product, you must have:

- 1. A **plan** that describes the 5 conditions/events of the tree's life
- 2. A **neatly drawn & labelled tree cookie diagram** that shows the **5** realistic conditions/events that happened to the tree and the correct number of rings (as accurate as possible) for the age. *Complete diagram at the end.*
- 3. An introductory paragraph that explains:
- The name and type of tree
- The age of the tree
- Where in Alberta this tree would have lived
- The 5 conditions/ events that happened to it
- 4. **Five** event information paragraphs with information on each of the **5** events/conditions that explain in <u>detail</u>:
 - What is the event? When did the event happen? Why did it happen?
 - How has the event impacted the tree?
- 5. Satisfying ending to your story to wrap up your tree's life and conditions/events.

Remember....

- Your story should include vivid description and detail clearly explaining the conditions impacting your tree.
- Weave in scientific vocabulary and knowledge to accurately and effectively describe your tree's life.
- You must ensure you have thoroughly **edited/revised** your story to make sure you have proper punctuation, capitals, effective organization of events to enhance flow, and limit spelling errors of scientific terms and unknown words.
